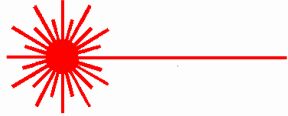




## Leland Yacht Club Laser Regatta

# Notice of Race

The Organizing Authority is the Leland Yacht Club, 1221 Juniper Trail, Leland, Michigan.

1. Rules:
  - 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
  - 1.2. Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
  - 1.3. Unofficial "Practice" Sails (not Class Legal) may be used.
  - 1.4. Competitors may choose Standard, Radial or 4.7 rigs at their discretion, provided that all rig changes are made on shore and all sails have the same number. All entrants will start, finish and be scored together.
2. Fees:
  - 2.1. The regatta fee is \$35.
3. Schedule:
  - 3.1. Saturday July 26
    - 1000 to 1200 hrs Check-In and Registration.
    - 1200 hrs Skipper's Meeting.
    - 1300 hrs First warning signal
  - 3.2. Sunday July 27
    - 1000 hrs First warning signal
    - No warning signal after 1300.
    - Awards to follow immediately after racing.
  - 3.3. The number of races to be held each day will be at the discretion of the Race Committee.
4. Registration:
  - 4.1. Saturday on-site.
5. Sailing Instructions:
  - 5.1. Available prior to the Skipper's Meeting.
6. Courses and Racing Area:
  - 6.1. Courses will be windward-leeward, triangles, or combinations thereof.
  - 6.2. The racing area will be on North Lake Leelanau.
7. Scoring:
  - 7.1. Scoring per RRS 90.3.

- 7.2. A minimum of one race will constitute a regatta.
  - 7.3. When six or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score, except for the score for disqualification as provided in RRS 90.3.
8. Awards:
    - 8.1. Awards will be for first thru third place overall, first woman, first junior, first Grand Master and first Great Grand Master.
9. Disclaimer of Liability:
    - 9.1. Competitors participate in the regatta at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
10. Housing: we will attempt to provide housing at fleet member homes. Call Tom Pendergast to inquire.
